Measures 1-4 of the piece. The right hand starts with a whole rest in measures 1 and 2, then plays a sequence of notes in measures 3 and 4: G4 (finger 5), A4 (finger 1), B4 (finger 2), and C5 (finger 5). The left hand plays a sequence of notes: G3 (finger 5), F3 (finger 5), E3 (finger 3), D3 (finger 3), C3 (finger 1), and B2 (finger 1).

Measures 5-8. The right hand has whole rests in measures 5 and 6, then plays G4 (finger 5), A4 (finger 1), B4 (finger 2), and C5 (finger 5) in measures 7 and 8. The left hand continues with G3 (finger 5), F3 (finger 5), E3 (finger 3), D3 (finger 3), C3 (finger 1), and B2 (finger 1).

Measures 9-12. The right hand has whole rests in measures 9 and 10, then plays G4 (finger 5), A4 (finger 1), B4 (finger 2), and C5 (finger 5) in measure 11, followed by a slur over B4, A4, and G4 in measure 12. The left hand continues with G3 (finger 5), F3 (finger 5), E3 (finger 3), D3 (finger 3), C3 (finger 1), and B2 (finger 1).

Measures 13-16. The right hand has whole rests in measures 13 and 14, then plays a slur over G4 (finger 4), F4 (finger 4), E4 (finger 2), and D4 (finger 1) in measure 15, followed by a slur over G4 (finger 4), F4 (finger 2), and E4 (finger 1) in measure 16. The left hand continues with G3 (finger 5), F3 (finger 5), E3 (finger 3), D3 (finger 3), C3 (finger 1), and B2 (finger 1).

Measures 17-20. The right hand has whole rests in measures 17 and 18, then plays a slur over G4 (finger 5), F4 (finger 5), E4 (finger 3), and D4 (finger 3) in measure 19, followed by a slur over G4 (finger 5), F4 (finger 5), E4 (finger 3), and D4 (finger 3) in measure 20. The left hand continues with G3 (finger 5), F3 (finger 5), E3 (finger 3), D3 (finger 3), C3 (finger 1), and B2 (finger 1).

L.H. cross over
