Adeste Fideles is commonly attributed to the 18th-Century hymnist John Francis Wade, although the authorship is somewhat uncertain.

The present arrangement is for SATB choir, brass quintet, organ, and timpani was composed for, and premiered at, the University of the South's annual Lessons and Carols services in December, 2022 in All Saints Chapel.

The arrangement includes a colorful opening fanfare, verses with and without brass, a verse with organ in trio texture under unison melody, an interlude, and rousing brass descants on the final verse... four verses in total. Amidst the colorful brass writing the choral harmonizations are standard to facilitate both choir and congregational singing.

The verse with choir and organ has been cued in the brass parts which allows for performance without choir.
