This block contains measures 5 through 9 of the musical score. Measures 5 and 6 are mostly rests for the brass instruments. Measures 7 and 8 feature a melodic line in the upper brass (Trumpets and Horns) with a trill (tr) in measure 8. Measure 9 continues the melodic development with trills in the upper brass. The lower brass (Trombone and Tuba) provides a steady rhythmic accompaniment throughout.

10 11 12 13 14

This block contains measures 10 through 14 of the musical score. Measures 10 and 11 show a more active role for the upper brass with trills and sixteenth-note patterns. Measures 12 and 13 continue this texture. Measure 14 concludes the section with a final trill in the upper brass and a sustained note in the lower brass.
