Behold a Ladder Set Up On the Earth

Genesis 28:12: “*And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it.*”

This composition touches upon both the thoughtful meditation and the emotional response to the lyrics of the African American slave spiritual “We Are Climbing Jacob's Ladder.”

A variation of the well-known theme is stated in the opening Adagio trumpet solo and then repeated several times throughout the piece. A more upbeat Allegro variation then enters before the familiar tune is finally introduced calmly by the bassoon. Using the given rhythmic divisions, emphasize the pulses during the mixed meter phrases from measure 30 to 41. The ensemble must work to balance to the melodic lines throughout. There are abundant opportunities for both sensitive and robust musical moments.

During the call and response climax in the organ-like Religioso section, maintain rhythmic clarity in the tied patterns with the use of slight separation. (Notice the change in patterns in measure 103). The upper woodwinds should be allowed to present the top register at full volume. In the closing moments, the low winds “climb Jacob's Ladder” one last time!
