Richard Strauss' *Fanfare from Stadt Wien* is a shortened work taken from the highlights of his larger work *Festmusik der Stadt Wien* (“Stadt Wien” translates to “City of Vienna”). This work was originally dedicated to Vienna and was scored for ten trumpets, seven trombones, two tubas and timpani.

In this arrangement for 9 trumpets, the use of flugel horns in the lower three trumpet parts is optional as is the timpani part.

This arrangement works ideally for a massed ensemble where each part can be at least doubled, enabling the staggering of parts and doubling only from rehearsal B to the end.

To facilitate the performance of the written pedal F's in this arrangement, utilize a 1-2-3 fingering and fully extend the third valve slide to bring the pitch down. On most trumpets, this might mean unscrewing any slide stops to enable the third slide to extend fully and/or using the first slide to bring the pitch down far enough. If the pedal F cannot be executed in tune with a centered sound consistently, it is acceptable to play these pitches up an octave.

The entire trumpet 1 part works very well on E-flat trumpet.
