Bert Truax was Second Trumpet with the Dallas Symphony for 23 years. He also played Second Trumpet for the Philadelphia orchestra during their 1985-86 season. As a successful composer, Bert has had commissions from the Dallas Symphony, the Dallas Bach Society, the Military Academy at West Point, and New York Philharmonic Principal Trombonist Joseph Alessi. He continues to freelance and compose in the Dallas metroplex.
