The Composer

Born in Columbus, Ohio, David Shaffer holds a bachelor's degree from Ohio State University and a Master of Music degree from Miami University in Ohio. Mr. Shaffer has taught in the Hamilton, Northridge, and Wyoming, Ohio, schools. Under his direction, the Wyoming High School String Orchestra performed as the opening group at the 1984 Midwest Clinic. During the summers of 1986 and 1992, he served as instrumental director for the Saskatchewan School of Fine Arts. And in February of 1997, he conducted a program of his music with the China Youth Corps Band in the National Concert Hall in Taipei, Taiwan.

Mr. Shaffer has over 250 compositions and arrangements in print. His works have been performed at clinics and music festivals around the world and have been placed on several state contest lists. Mr. Shaffer is in demand as a conductor for new music reading sessions, music festivals, and music education seminars. Currently, he is a freelance composer, arranger, and clinician, and is on the music faculty at Miami University.

About the Music

This cooked up concoction of classics is a cacophony of craziness sure to catapult your audience into choruses of cackles as you capture the comedic chemistry of the piece.

Be sure to take liberties with the kitchen percussion and other toy instruments. At measure 32, trombone glissandos and flute trills should be exaggerated. Emphasize the tempo changes at measures 50 and 58, and the accelerando into measure 69.

For the beginning, I suggest using large pots and pans with metal beaters for maximum resonance. In measure 24, you may have all of the wind players who are not playing between measures 24–32 also play the "silverware" percussion part. As another suggestion for comedic purposes, use very large trash can lids as cymbals, and have all of the remaining percussionists play this part, possibly in front of the band. Make sure the blender part at the end is emphasized visually.

There are endless possibilities for adding visual and sonic additions, and creating a delightful and entertaining performance.
