

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The Composer

William Owens (b. 1963) is a native of Gary, Indiana and a 1985 graduate of VanderCook College of Music in Chicago. A seasoned music educator, Mr. Owens is active as a composer, conductor and clinician throughout the United States and Canada. Mr. Owens has written nearly 200 commissioned and published works for concert band and string orchestra. His music has been programmed at prestigious venues such as the Midwest Clinic and appears on required music lists both nationally and abroad. Principal commissions include those from the California Band Directors Association, the Chicago Public Schools Bureau of Cultural Arts, the South Plains College Dept. of Fine Arts and the Texas University Interscholastic League. He is a consistent winner of the ASCAPPlus award and a two-time recipient of the Forrest L. Buchtel Citation for Excellence in Composition. Professional memberships include ASCAP, the American Composers Forum and the Texas MEA. William resides in Fort Worth, TX with his wife, Georgia.

Program Notes

With driving rhythms and an array of tonal colors, *Heroes Triumphant* is a musical manifestation of vivacity and high spirits. Beginning quite crisply, the trumpet section is heard in a bright fanfare fashion. The full ensemble soon comes together with bold sweeping chords and strong melodic concentrations. The music then calms briefly before building back to the initial driving style and coming to a rousing conclusion.

Heroes Triumphant was commissioned by the Association of Texas Small School Bands to honor Mr. George Riddell, a longtime music educator and friend of the ATSSB Region 16.

Rehearsal Suggestions

The character of the work can be best achieved if played at the top end of the suggested metronome marking. Attention to dynamics is vital, particularly in the accompaniment parts, as the melody can otherwise be shadowed. While the music is largely aggressive, the section at measure 22 should be equally gentle. The section at measure 39 should have a driving “groove” feel, but not be overstated.
