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The Composer

William Owens (b. 1963) is a native of Gary, Indiana and a 1985 graduate of VanderCook College of Music in Chicago. A seasoned music educator, Mr. Owens is active as a composer, conductor and clinician throughout the United States and Canada. Mr. Owens has written nearly 200 commissioned and published works for concert band and string orchestra. His music has been programmed at prestigious venues such as the Midwest Clinic and appears on required music lists both nationally and abroad. Principal commissions include those from the California Band Directors Association, the Chicago Public Schools Bureau of Cultural Arts, the South Plains College Dept. of Fine Arts and the Texas University Interscholastic League. He is a consistent winner of the ASCAP Plus award and a two-time recipient of the Forrest L. Buchtel Citation for Excellence in Composition. Professional memberships include ASCAP, the American Composers Forum and the Texas MEA. William resides in Fort Worth, TX with his wife, Georgia.

Program Notes

The House of Tudor was a European royal house that ruled the kingdoms of England and Ireland from 1485 to 1603. During this dynastic period, music became so highly regarded that a person was not considered to be a gentleman or gentlewoman unless he or she could read music or sing tolerably.

The music of the day was known for its steady rhythm and polyphony, a main theme that is established then played in different ways. Most notably, Queen Elizabeth I was an accomplished musician and made it essential for courtiers to understand the art of music.

In three movement form, *Tudor Sketches* is a work based on songs and styles of this revolutionary musical era.

A blithely woodwind anthem and a rollicking dance heralds in *Hampton Court*, a principal residence of King Henry VIII and the epicenter of royal social activity.

Good Queen Bess, the regal second movement, depicts the court of Queen Elizabeth I, often referred to as Good Queen Bess. The intrepid *Hunting at Chobham* portrays an aggressive game of chase in the vast 500 acre hunting park held by the Tudors for nearly 70 years.

Rehearsal Suggestions

Hampton Court - The initial statement must have a flowing, but straightforward motion. The dance section at measure 41 is light and animated. Regarding balance, please work for an even exchange between woodwinds and brasses.

Good Queen Bess - This movement should have a relaxed but stately quality. If crotales are not available, bells will make suitable substitute.

Hunting at Chobham - While aggressive in nature, care must be taken to play tastefully with a strong tonal concentration.
