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The Composer

Mekel Rogers has been involved in music education as a middle school band director since 1995. He is a *summa cum laude* graduate of Appalachian State University, a charter member of the Carolina Crown Drum and Bugle Corps, and the founding conductor of the Union Symphony Youth Orchestra. He currently serves as the director of bands for Weddington Middle School in Union County, North Carolina. Mekel was inducted into the American School Band Directors Association in 2008.

Mekel frequently serves as a guest clinician at various honor band clinics and university invitationals. He is also a respected adjudicator for many concert band and marching band events. His compositions have been performed at the Midwest Clinic in Chicago, and at various concert band festivals, honor band clinics, and other music educator conferences throughout the United States. Mekel resides in North Carolina with his wife and daughter.

About the Music

Pulsate is a fast, exciting, rhythmic piece that will help develop student counting skills and independent musical responsibility. The entire composition is in 3/4 time but the odd numbered measures contain syncopations that hint at a 6/8 meter. In rehearsal, work the rhythms found in the full band from measures 17-20 to get the style and feel of the alternating pulse before working the rest of the piece.

Pay close attention to the various accidentals throughout. Although the pitches themselves are not difficult to play, they are notated in ways that are less commonly seen in music at this level. Having students familiar with enharmonic equivalents will be very helpful in teaching pitches.

If a marimba is not available, the marimba part can be played effectively on a xylophone using rubber mallets. Keep the tempo steady and quick, always going for a light and slightly separated style to maintain forward momentum. Most of all, keep it exciting, and enjoy performing *Pulsate*.
