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## The Composer

Mark Lortz is the Director of Bands at Stevenson University and brass arranger for The Reading Buccaneers drum corps. He has earned music performance, education and composition degrees from the Peabody Conservatory of Music and has earned a University Fellowship at the Boyer College of Music and Dance of Temple University, where he is pursuing a doctorate of music education. Mark is an award-winning band and orchestra composer and an in demand adjudicator, clinician and guest conductor throughout the country.

Mr. Lortz's original music has premiered at the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic, the Bands of America National Percussion Festival and the College Band Directors National Association. "The Caw of the Wild," his commissioned composition for the Baltimore Ravens NFL football team's marching band, is performed at every Ravens home game. Lortz's compositions have received awards from the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP) and laudatory reviews in *Gramophone* and *The Instrumentalist*. They also made *Bandworld's* Top 100 list of band compositions and sheet music company JW Pepper's *Editor's Choice* list.

He was Associate Music Director and Principal Percussionist for the North American tour of *Phantom of the Opera* and Principal Percussionist with the international performing ensemble, The Dallas Brass. He has performed and recorded with premier orchestras, including the Baltimore Symphony.

Mr. Lortz lives in Harford County, Maryland, with his wife, Cate, and their dog.

## Program Notes

Dedicated to the 2016 Howard County Gifted and Talented Band, (Columbia, Maryland), *Fuego Español* is a Latin-inspired showstopper for mature concert bands. Blending classic Latin-American styles and exciting, contemporary, Latin-inspired dance rhythms, this invigorating piece features every section of the band and will bring your concert to a spirited finish.

The piece has three distinct sections. The first is a typical Spanish fanfare that quickly develops into a fiery Latin montuno groove based upon the 3-2 clave. The second section (Rehearsal 12), introduces the piece's motive and weaves through a variety of moods and emotions.

The concluding section (Rehearsal 79) is an extremely exciting and fast motuno groove introduced first in the woodwinds and mallet instruments. The piece reaches a fervent apex at Rehearsal 94 and suddenly begins an intense build to a fiery conclusion.

Written for 6 percussionists and 1 timpanist, there is a strong sense of *ad libitum* and improvisation that could be performed within the Latin accessory instruments. The Percussion 1 part could be played on drum set.
