The following conventions are employed in notating trills:

1. When the note to be trilled is written as a single note, without ties, the normal trill sign indicates a trill lasting the duration of the note.



2. When a tie is required to indicate the duration of the note to be trilled, the normal trill is followed by a wavy line indicating that the trill continues through the value of the tied note.



3. In the following example, the square corner bracket ʌ is used to indicate the extent of the trill. Here it indicates that the performer is to trill for a quarter note duration, ending on the principal note without reattacking.



4. In the final example, the performer is to trill through the quarter plus eighth duration, ending on the principal note without reattacking.
