Percussion II: 3 toms (low, medium, and high), xylophone (shared), glockenspiel, bass drum (shared), suspended China cymbal, snare drum

Harp

Violin I section, with Solo Violin parts I, II, and III taken from this group

Violin II section, with Solo Violin parts IV, V, and VI taken from this group

All instruments are notated at sounding pitch (in C), though standard octave transpositions remain in effect for piccolo, basses, xylophone, and glockenspiel.
