Program Notes: Flee! / Sad / Evade / Flee! / Refuge

"Flee!" was written in 2021 during the covid-19 crisis. Originally planned to be premiered at the summer 2021 SAI National Convention, like so many compositions from this period, the convention, and thus the premiere, was delayed by a year. Later, as live gatherings and concerts were reinstated, a new sense of the joy and wonder of live music prevailed for musicians and audiences alike.. Flee! was premiered on July 29,2022 at the Sigma Alpha Iota National Convention in Greensboro, North Carolina.

"Flee!" is a novella, a short story. Imagine being captive, the opportunity arises, take a chance and flee, mixing the exuberance of restored freedom with the fear of recapture. At Sad, pause to think of those still in captivity, but not for long. Danger! During the four episodes in Evade leap, hide, scurry, and project bravado until the coast is clear, and once again, Flee!
