NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

In measure 11, the lower voices should have a marcato feel while the upper voices should be staccato in contrast. The full band should be maestoso at measure 19 and then quickly turn to a more sinister feel at measure 28.

At measure 34, the articulations are crucial to create contrast. Make sure the band gets down to piano at measure 42. The piece returns to a heroic and celebratory maestoso at measure 44 to the end.

John M. Pasternak has composed for and directed community ensembles throughout the Northeast Ohio area since 2003. His Bachelor's Degree in Music Education is from Kent State University (KSU) where he served as President of their Ohio Collegiate Music Education Association (OCMEA) Chapter. In 2008 John was elected as a member of the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP).

Pasternak's experience includes composing and conducting works with and for KSU ensembles. He completed a film score for an independent KSU film Breaking News and in 2012, he completed his film score for Research: The Musical.
