PROGRAM NOTE

Do not walk. You must run through the wolves' den. Be fearless and do not hide. You can hear them howling behind you. With the light of your torch, you can see their shadows on the walls. You have no idea how you ended up here, but you know you have to get out fast. Do not walk. Run through the wolves' den!

NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

Make note of the tempo marking and try to keep it consistent throughout the piece. Use a metronome to help the students maintain tempo and pulse control. I would suggest slowing it down to rehearse sections or phrases gradually speeding back up to the marked tempo. Be diligent with this tool and it will be rewarding.

Please be sure the students are aware of the notated dynamic and articulation markings and their meanings/interpretation. These markings are what translates emotion and suspense to the audience. Feel free to alter these markings if needed for your particular situation and interpretation.

Encourage the students to listen and balance their musical line to the other sections. Once they begin to hear their sounds blending, they will start to achieve a more mature ensemble sound along with better intonation.

In order to push the horn players and create energy, direct the percussion section to play a bit aggressively but always maintaining control. The ride cymbal has an integral role in this work and helps to create a sense of forward momentum.

While rehearsing this piece, teach your students to breath at the ends of phrases and to use plenty of air support while sustaining their tone. Remind them to relax as they are in control of their instruments. Most of all, remind them that music should be fun and exciting!
