NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

The style of this work is bold and heroic. The prescribed tempo, articulations and dynamic markings are very important to convey the correct style. However, feel free to adjust as needed for your ensemble.

Please ask the students to work hard to balance the ensemble. They should play with intensity but with a uniform approach in order to achieve clarity in their overall sound. Be mindful of the balance between percussion and winds.

The Blacksmith's Blade was commissioned by the 2018 Albemarle County Middle School Honor Band in Albemarle County, Virginia.
