PROGRAM NOTE

The term “enclave” refers to a portion of territory within or surrounded by a larger territory whose inhabitants are culturally distinct. *Enclave Fanfare* is a dramatic musical statement by our culturally distinctive ensemble complete with bold brass, powerful percussion and wondrous woodwinds. This majestic work by composer Brian Bankston is a declaration to all from the distinct music ensembles of our world.

NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

Please adhere to the marked tempo of 104 and avoid any tendency by the ensemble to perform this too quickly. Strive for a steady pulse throughout.

Maximize the dynamic contrast of the *forte piano* in measure 1 to create a strong introduction for the trumpets.

The orchestration will vary throughout with contrasting textures. Please be sure to balance all parts in each textural setting.

Focusing on the triplet rhythms early in the piece will help to define and develop the style throughout the piece.

Encourage the band to play relaxed yet powerfully. Make sure not to let energy or excitement cause the players to overblow.

Special attention should be given to all dynamics and articulations in order to maximize the dramatic effect of the piece.

Please encourage the French Horns and Alto Saxophones to glissando as smoothly as possible.
