## PROGRAM NOTE

*Right About March* evokes images of the “Golden Age” of the concert band. This delightful work of musical Americana brings you back to a time when every town had a community concert band and weekend afternoons were spent in the park listening to the most wonderful music. Grab a picnic basket, a blanket and enjoy the concert!

## NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

The opening statement should be bold and energetic. The staccato articulation should be light and clean.

At letter A, the melody is in the upper woodwinds and trumpets. The horns and trombones have a countermelody and should lay just below the melody in terms of balance.

At letter B, please note contrast in the melody between the staccato and legato sections. Work to maximize that contrast for musical effect.

In the trio, the trumpet entrance should be bold and in contrast with the lyrical melody.

As always, dynamics and dynamic contrast are important to fulfilling the character of the march. Maintain the same march tempo throughout or try slowing down 2 measures before F.

I hope you and the band enjoy rehearsing and performing *Right About March*. Best wishes!
