### PROGRAM NOTE

The composer writes, "I've always been inspired by a famous speech, titled "The Man in the Arena", by US President Theodore Roosevelt, delivered shortly after his presidency in 1910."

The most famous excerpt from this speech is as follows:

*It is not the critic who counts: not the man who points out how the strong man stumbles or where the doer of deeds could have done better. The credit belongs to the man who is actually in the arena, whose face is marred by dust and sweat and blood, who strives valiantly, who errs and comes up short again and again, because there is no effort without error or shortcoming, but who knows the great enthusiasms, the great devotions, who spends himself in a worthy cause; who, at the best, knows, in the end, the triumph of high achievement, and who, at the worst, if he fails, at least he fails while daring greatly so that his place shall never be with those cold and timid souls who knew neither victory nor defeat.*

Theodore Roosevelt; speech at the Sorbonne, Paris, France, April 23, 1910

"These words have reverberated and inspired through history in a myriad of spaces; from presidents and politicians to sports figures, musical artists, tv commercials, motivational speakers, and beyond.

As a young person, and even still, the fear of failure is a daunting obstacle for me as it is with many others of all ages. For those at the start of their musical journey, performing in front of an audience can be a major first hurdle on the road to success. In writing *To Dare Greatly*, it was my aim to provide a vehicle for the beginning band musician to experience a successful first performance. It is my hope this composition, and the words that inspired it, will serve to embolden young musicians everywhere *To Dare Greatly!*"

### NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

This concert opener was written with the beginning band in mind, with careful attention to range, rhythmic challenge, and independence. A largely consistent percussion presence throughout can be helpful in ensuring ensemble vertical alignment. Additionally, considerations have been taken to ensure playability with limited instrumentation.

Take full advantage of dynamic contrasts, particularly any sudden dynamic contrasts, written into the music! If possible, perform unmarked eighth notes in a "lifted", or slightly separated style. From a balance perspective, identify melodic lines and ensure that these are heard more than other accompaniment lines played concurrently.


