INFINITY PERCUSSION was founded in 2007 by Tom Hurst, John Campese, and Lee Hansen, and was comprised of staff and members of the 2006 WGI Independent Open Class championship ensemble, First Degree (Orlando, FL). From its inception, INFINITY was created for the highest level of performance competition (Independent World Class) and has been a WGI World Class Finalist every year since 2008.

In 2013, the organization welcomed a new ensemble to the Infini-Family - INFINITY 2. Adding a second ensemble to the organization extends to more young performers the opportunity to be a part of INFINITY PERCUSSION and provides the same training, techniques, and culture that is promoted within the World Class ensemble. INFINITY PERCUSSION is an affiliate of Pageantry Arts Concepts, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. As a PAC affiliate, our goal is to provide youth and young adults the opportunity to enhance their performance and musical skills while furthering their knowledge of the marching arts activity in a professional setting.

#### PROGRAM NOTE

**Ritmo Bongito** is written for a large percussion ensemble, featuring a bongo ostinato and a diverse array of other instruments. With Latin-inspired rhythms and European-influenced melodies, the piece combines elements from multiple cultures to create a unique musical experience.

The bongo ostinato serves as the backbone of the composition, driving the piece forward and providing a consistent rhythmic pulse. The other percussion instruments weave in and out, adding texture and color to the ensemble's sound.

Throughout the piece, the composers explore the interplay between rhythms and melodies, creating moments of tension and release. The Latin feel provides a lively and upbeat atmosphere, while the melodies bring a sense of familiarity and comfort to the piece.

A dynamic and engaging composition, Ritmo Bongito showcases the versatility and creativity of the percussion ensemble.

#### **NOTES TO CONDUCTOR**

This composition can be performed in both a traditional percussion ensemble setup, as well as along the back row of a concert band. This facilitates the programming of *Ritmo Bonqito* as part of a full concert band performance.

The order of the ensemble (left to right, front to back, etc.) is also subject to interpretation. The only shared instrument between two parts is a triangle by Percussion 4 and Percussion 5, but that can be ignored if both parts have their own triangles.

Percussion 4 (Bongos) should be played with sticks but can also be performed with hands if preferred. If the program does not have all the available cymbals for the Perc 6 part, the piece can be performed with just a hi-hat and suspended cymbal. The marimba part can be substituted with a xylophone played with yarn mallets.
