Leaf in the Wind is truly a self-descriptive piece. No two leaves have ever drifted in the breeze in the exact same motion or direction. In the same way, every performance of this piece provides a different experience and interpretation, both for the listener and the performer. Allow yourself to be set adrift in the wind and taken to a place you may not have expected. After all, music is not just about the sound. It's about the experience.

NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

The most important aspect of this piece is its motion. Even in the slower, less busy sections of the piece, there still needs to be a feeling of motion.

In preparing the piece, I believe it will be crucial the players are of one mind. Everything must be felt together if the piece is to be communicated as intended. It will also be important to allow room for soloing sections to be expressive in their interpretations.

Perhaps the most tender moment of the piece is when the melody is rearticulated in the violas beginning in measure 30. The rest of the ensemble must have a heightened awareness of the viola melody and be actively listening as they provide the accompaniment.
