## Rehearsal Notes

*Snowflakes* is an easy piece for the first-year string player. The violin 2, viola, cello, and bass parts are written on the D and A strings only. Violin 1 uses the E string sparingly. This piece can be used with the Real Music for Beginning Band publication of the same title. To do so, tune all strings a half step higher (D to D $\sharp$  or E $\flat$ , A to A $\sharp$  or B $\flat$ , etc.), and omit the piano part.
