About the Music

The transcendent beauty of this arrangement of the last movement of Fauré's *Requiem Mass* is guaranteed to induce goose bumps in audiences and performers alike. The technical ease of this arrangement leaves the player free to concentrate on communicating the emotion and expression of Faure's vision. The (optional) harp/keyboard part is included.

Although at first your students may question the relative ease of this piece, they should be quickly won over by the beauty and lushness of the music. With very few technical demands your students can focus on intonation, tone, and listening across the ensemble as well as expression. If you do not use the harp part, you may take more liberties with the tempo.
