About the Music

African American Spirituals often reflect one or both of two sentiments: hope and/or hardship. In this spiritual, the feeling of despair seems overwhelming, with the occasional interjection of "true believer" – $\downarrow \cdot \downarrow \downarrow \downarrow$ – suggesting encouragement to hold on to hope.

*Sometimes I feel like a motherless child,
Sometimes I feel like a motherless child,
Sometimes I feel like a motherless child,
A long way from home...
True believer!*

To balance the musical representation of despair and desolation, this arrangement includes a contrasting statement of another spiritual, *I've Got Peace Like a River*. This tune shares the "true believer" rhythmic motif $\downarrow \cdot \downarrow \downarrow \downarrow$ for its text "...like a river."

Strict adherence to dynamics, articulations, and accidentals as well as attention to careful bow control will help convey the feelings ranging from hopelessness to tranquility. Shifting is required only in 1st violin, cello, and bass, although advanced fingerings in other sections can be added by the teacher where desired. The dense scoring requires some double stops and divisi.
