About the Music

This folk song depicts a woman who wants to cross the River Tyne in northeastern England. She laments being separated from a man she loves, "for the water of Tyne runs between him and me." The melody encapsulates a feeling of longing which can be portrayed with smooth bow strokes and flowing, dramatic gestures in the accompanying parts.

The 6/8 meter should feel generally steady, but not restrained at phrase endings or textural changes. Voice-like blending, breathing, and melodic phrasing will further help demonstrate a yearning for the unreachable.
