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The Composer

A graduate of the Faculty of Music at the University of Toronto, Scott majored in clarinet, studying with the virtuoso Joaquim Valdepenas. There he pursued studies in arranging, orchestration and music pedagogy. Scott has been actively engaged in adult and youth music education for over 30 years, as a teacher, director, and mentor in the instrumental and vocal music areas. A frequently commissioned composer, he has written over 75 compositions in varied genres, including symphony orchestra, string orchestra, choir, jazz orchestra, popular song, and the stage musical. His work has a contemporary and fresh feel to it, with a leaning toward strong melody and catchy rhythmic content. Scott has a particular interest in composing pieces for developing string players. He is a member of The Canadian League of Composers.

About the Music

Urbanicity: The quality or fact of an area being urban

Urbanicity is an energetic romp based around a repeated rhythmic cell. Contemporary and fresh, it is shrouded in a sense of excitement and anticipation, with interesting material shared among all the sections. The basic theme is stated at the outset by the upper strings. After this dramatic setting of the stage, the cellos and violas present a version of the first statement of the melody in diminution, followed by a complementary countermelody in the first violins. After a contrasting bridge, the cellos then present the melody in a lower octave, before a rousing ensemble ending with all the stops pulled out.

Rehearsal Notes

The double notes in the cello at measures 5-8 and measures 71-74 can be played non-divisi or divisi at the discretion of the director.
