The Composer

Kathryn Griesinger received her B.A. (cello) and M.M. (music education) degrees from the University of Akron in Ohio, where she later taught string pedagogy courses as adjunct faculty. She taught orchestra in Lake Local private and public schools for 13 years, while freelancing as an arranger and cellist for various ensembles. Kathryn has composed sight-reading music for regional music festivals, and her pieces have been performed by honors and festival orchestras in several states. She enjoys writing fun and exciting music for students that supports developing playing technique. Kathryn is currently the Orchestra Editor for J.W. Pepper and String Editor for Wingert-Jones Publications in Pennsylvania.

About the Music

This swashbuckling musical tale features three pirate-like characters, represented by the orchestra sections, each with their own adventurous theme. The first melody is heard in the violins from measure 1, followed by a viola feature at measure 25, and then the cello/bass section shine at measure 55. All parts remain in first position with minimal low-2 finger patterns. Cello and bass parts are nearly identical for a strong foundation, and second violins are often reinforced by violas or first violins with doubling. Players should observe all dynamics and listen carefully to other sections to bring out the featured theme when it occurs. Pizzicato notes in particular should be un-rushed and steady. Students may enjoy making up a story for their 'character' as the musical journey progresses. Each distinct tune comes together at the end for a triumphant finish!
